Admission

To be considered for admission, international undergraduate applicants should submit the following items:

- Application for International Undergraduate Admission
- Nonrefundable application fee
- Official secondary and/or postsecondary academic records*
- Proof of English proficiency

*Transfer students with international transcripts should submit a course-by-course evaluation.

In order to have an I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant [F-1] Student Status) issued, international students are also required to submit the Confidential Financial Information Form along with documents showing they have sufficient financial resources to fund their education in the United States.
